An integral part of the Rotary International Youth Exchange Programme is the support network offered by the programme. An important role in this support network is that of the Student Counsellor. District 9940 requires that a counsellor is appointed from the Sponsoring Club to liaise with both the student and the student's family, as well if necessary, with the Host Club Counsellor whilst the student is away overseas. It is recommended that a female counsellor be appointed for a female student and a male counsellor to a male student.

Expectations of the Sponsoring Club Counsellor are:

- Ensures that the student is familiar with Rotary and the activities of the Club and District
- Assists with transportation to Orientation Weekend and other District functions
- Arranges for student and student's parents to attend a Club meeting before departure and after return home.
- Be active in assisting with any New Zealand based issues whilst the student is abroad through maintaining regular contact via mail, e-mail, text or the internet and where appropriate, keeping the District Committee informed.
- Authorise the District Committee to seek a satisfactory Police Screening report
